# Observer Oath, Rights & Responsibilities

## Observer Responsibilities:

1. At 4:30 a.m. report to assigned boat to spend the day monitoring assigned team for compliance of rules.
2. Observer monitors to ensure there is no cell phone use from 5:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Saturday and from 5:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. on Sunday. Only VHF Channel 72 will be monitored.
3. Using Log & Score Sheet form, observer records each of the ten (10) fish that are to be weighed and registered.
4. The observer ensures that start time (5:00 A.M.) and end time (1:00 P.M.) on Saturday and start time (5:00 A.M.) and end time (10:00 A.M.) on Sunday and overall rules are obeyed, keeping the tournament fair for everyone.
5. At the end of the fishing day, the observer and the captain must both sign the observer log and submit, said log with their catch at weigh in.
6. Observers must be at least 18 years of age with a valid ID. No Derby Ticket or fishing license is required, since the observer is not allowed to help the fishermen on the boat.
7. Observers should treat persons and property on their assigned boats with courtesy and respect, and should not hinder team members from fishing.

## Observer Rights:

1. Observers are **Tournament Officials** because they judge whether tournament rules are obeyed during the competition.
2. Observers have the right to be treated by the captain and all team members on assigned boat with courtesy and respect.
3. Observers have the right to move freely about on the boat.
4. Observers have the right to inspect each fish caught on the boat for time of catch, approximate weight, species, and exact size – making sure the 15 inch minimum size limit is obeyed.

## Team Responsibilities for Observers:

1. It is the responsibility of each team to provide an observer for the day of the tournament.
2. If a team fails to have their observer at the assigned boat by 4:30 a.m. the morning of the tournament, they are disqualified.
3. The name of your observer should be on your registration form, or phoned in to (920) 860-0160 Tom Kocourek by close of registration, Friday July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.
4. Assigned observers on boat during competition are to be treated with courtesy and respect. Observers are tournament officials who will verify that you have complied with the rules of the tournament.

## Observers Oath:

1. I swear that I will uphold the rules of this tournament and those of the WDNR.
2. I swear that I will be dependable during my engagement and prompt to my boat assignment.
3. I swear that I will not participate in any betting activities, nor will I accept gifts, monetary or otherwise from the contestants or members of the crew.
4. I swear that all information on my application form is correct.
5. I swear that I understand and agree to hold harmless N.E.W.G.L.S.F. and all officers, committee members and everyone associated with the aforementioned groups and individuals on the boat that I am assigned to from damages incurred as a result of participation in the tournament in whatever form or manner said liabilities or damages might be incurred.
