Report From The Rearing Pond:

Wayne reports that we have approximately 15,000 German Browns in the pond. They are growing and are now in the 8 inch range. These Browns will be released around the first week of March. After the mechanical failures last winter at the rearing facility, NEWGLSF has done some major improvements, with an approximate cost of \$16,000. We installed new electrical wire underground to the pond, since we believe this was the main reason for the problems last winter. We now have 100 amp service **at the pond** instead of the old 20 amp service to the pond. This gives us the added capacity to install a larger pump or larger well in the future. Wayne also constructed a new pump house / storage building. Salt and other items needed for the pond now can be stored inside and out of sight. To stop the runoff rainwater from the birdcages at the zoo, we did some additional grading, rock filters and tiling. Wayne and his crew also put in some new treated boards 18 inches high around the pond with 36 inches of wire mesh; to this, the bird netting was secured. The old bird netting was breaking down close the ground. We are working on one additional **ISSUE** - A monitoring system that will indicate a power problem, a water flow problem, or if the water level in the pond drops. We cannot afford to have another die off like we had last winter.

DERBY NEWS: NEWGLSF Will No Longer Host The 333 Tournament Trail

We at NEWGLSF understand that some of you may be disappointed that we are no longer hosting the "333" Michigan Tournament Trail in 2012. The Derby Committee reviewed the pros and cons of the tournament trail after the derby last year. NEWGLSF was required to pay \$3,700.00 up front to host the Tournament Trail besides the \$100.00 per boat that our fishermen contributed, which was an additional \$4,100.00. In order to off-set these fees, we were supposed to get some local advertising in the form of Tournament Trail Magazines, which were to stimulate additional participation from local fishermen. Unfortunately, several boxes of the Tournament Trail Magazines, after several calls and e-mails, finally arrived a few days before the Derby, which provided little help in local promotion. When contacted about hosting the Tournament Trail in 2012, there was no movement on the fees NEWGLSF were to pay. We therefore felt it was no longer in our best interest to continue our relationship. If at sometime the organizers of the Tournament Trail would like to discuss coming back and being part of the NEWGLSF Salmon Derby, we will be more than ready to discuss the up front fees with them. Remember, the \$3700.00 up front fee comes directly out of the NEWGLSF Salmon Derby bottom line. The Salmon Derby Committee has already started working to provide our fishermen with the quality tournament you have been accustomed to in the past.
