Rearing Pond News:

At the present time our rearing facility has a healthy population of little Chinook Salmon. We have 89,000 Chinooks compared to the 86,000 Chinooks we had last year, therefore the reductions apparently will be in the fingerlings that are being planted directly into the various river systems. Our little Chinooks are being fed 3 times per day and will remain under our care until late May or early June, when they will be released into the Manitowoc River. In March we released approximately 22,000 Brown Trout, which we raised all winter. The Browns were all 8-12 inches long. Now we will have to wait a few years and see if raising Brown Trout will pay off with our Brown Trout Fishery. We also got an unexpected Stocking of 25,000 Coho from the Department of Natural Resources in March.

Legislative Report:

Assembly Bills AB 581 dealing with Commercial Fishing, and AB 486 concerning Double-crested Cormorant control, were both signed into law by Governor James Doyle last Friday by at the Wisconsin Wildlife Federation Annual Meeting which was held in Tomah, Wisconsin.

Assembly Bill 581 is the result of six years of work that began with the formation of a Commercial Fishing Taskforce, that was set in place by George Meyer who at the time was Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. This new Bill sets a framework for a general clean up of rules and regulations for the management and regulation of the Commercial Fishery. A point of key interest to this new legislation is the placement of an electronic monitoring system that will give the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources the ability to view up to the minute data on the time, location, and particular catch data of commercial vessels while they are on the water. The new rules will also greatly update the methods of reporting catch, sales, and inventory of Commercial Fishing activities, including those of Fish Wholesalers. The new rules also require an Inventory of all fish being held. The lack of some type of end point or starting point, regarding how many fish are in the freezers, has been a major obstacle in many investigations and will greatly enhance the Department's inspection procedures. Head WDNR Marine Warden Tomas Hansen of the Green Bay offices played a major roll in working with Representative Gary Bies of Door County in writing Bill 581 for presentation to the Legislature. At this point, Warden Hansen will do a re-write of the NR's based on AB 581, and the new Legislation should be in full effect within a few months.

Concerning the Cormorant issue, Bill AB 486 the new legislation will begin the process of getting hold of the damage and predation being done these birds. This bill is certainly not a catch all for all the problems caused by the Double-crested Cormorant, but at least it is a good start.

“Fishing Tips of the Month”

A Tip For Stacking Just A Few Feet Off the Ball or to a Diver:

All it takes is a piece of very small surgical tubing, a barrel swivel and a bead. Take a 1 inch piece of tubing and cut a notch in it so that the eye of the barrel swivel passes freely into the tube. Hint fold in half and cut off the corner. You'll get the hang for the size. On your main line thread the bead, than run the line through the tube and eye of the barrel swivel. The bead keeps you from reeling the rig past your rod tip. You need to hold the rig in your hand as you set your lure letting line out. Clip into your release, still holding the rig lower the ball 10 or more feet than attach a slider rig (piece of leader with two snap swivels) to the barrel swivel and lower away. Water pressure and the friction of the rubber should hold your stacker in place. When you reel in it will slide down. If you pre-rig all your down rigger rods this way you don't have to add the stacker but they are ready, and if not used cause no problem. This will also work well if you want to add a second lure to a diver rig.
